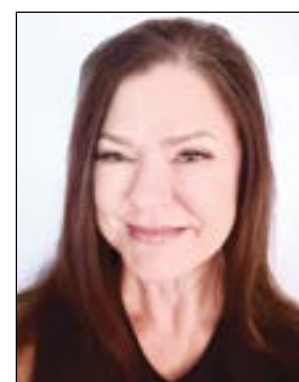
## A Message from the Chamber....

The library and Chamber also work together to support local businesses, encourage community connection, and build a more resilient community.

Libraries play an important role during emergencies and extreme weather, serving as trusted heating and cooling centers and providing access to critical services. Following the 2025 winter storms, the Snohomish Library was selected by the U.S. Small Business Administration as a Disaster Loan Outreach Center, helping local businesses and residents

access recovery resources and rebuild.

As Sno-Isle Libraries begins its strategic planning process, partnerships with the Chamber and community input will help guide priorities and ensure library services continue evolving to meet local needs. Residents will also help shape the library's future through the upcoming library levy vote. On August 4, voters will decide whether to restore the levy rate to \$0.47 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Learn more at [sno-isle.org/levy](https://sno-isle.org/levy).

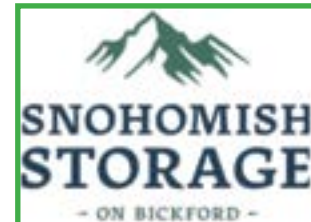
